## Uniform List

### Girls

- School red sweatshirt or cardigan with School Logo.
- Plain white polo shirt or white shirt.
- Dark grey knee length skirt/dark pinafore dress/dark grey trousers (No leggings)/dark grey culottes.
- Summer dress in red and white gingham check.
- White/grey socks.
- Sensible black school shoes- not trainers or boots.
- School Book bag.

### Boys

- School red sweatshirt with School Logo.
- Plain white polo shirt or white shirt.
- Dark grey trousers/shorts
- Black/grey socks.
- Sensible black school shoes- not trainers.
- School Book bag.

### PE Kit

- Plain white T-shirt and plain black shorts.
- Plain black tracksuit/leggings for outdoor PE.
- PE black pumps for indoor PE lessons, and white or black trainers for outdoor PE.
- PE Bag

- PE kit is to be kept in a named PE bag in school except when sent home for washing.

**Jewellery**

On Health and Safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school except watches from Year 2 onwards. Children with pierced ears may wear plain, neutral coloured stud earrings (max one earring per ear). Earrings must be removed or covered in PE lessons with plasters that the child must bring from home.

**Hair**

Children with hair shoulder length or longer must be tied back with a band. No large head bands or bows and hair accessories must be red, black or grey. White hair accessories may be worn with the white and red gingham summer dress. No extreme haircuts are allowed. Nail varnish and false nails are not allowed.
