

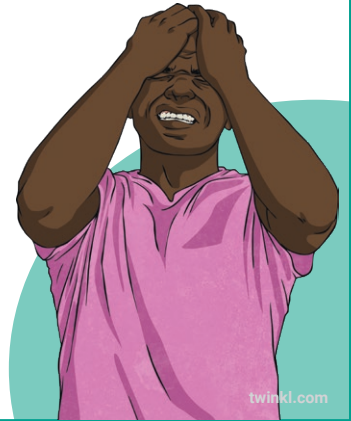
UKS2 Relationships Education Question Cards

How can we recognise who to trust and who not to trust?



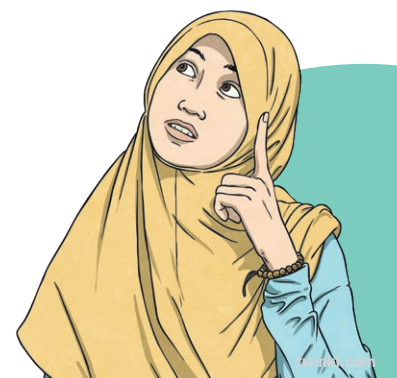
What sort of online behaviour might make someone feel unsafe?
