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At the park, the children are all playing on the roundabout. They are seeing how fast they can make it go. Everyone seems to like it going fast, except one child who really doesn't like the feeling.



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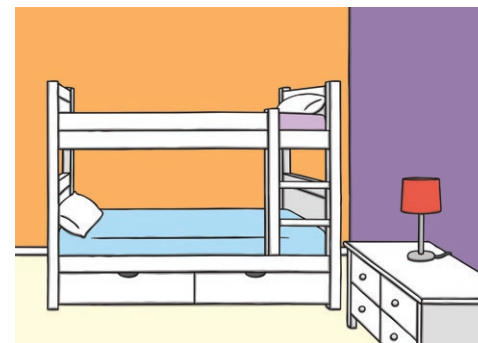
A group of friends are having a film night and they have chosen to watch a scary film. One of the children doesn't like the feeling of being scared and is uncomfortable watching the film.
