Early Help is delivered at neighbourhood level by all partners. Partners are supported to develop their skills and knowledge to support children using Early Help Assessment process and to act as Lead Professional. Advice and Guidance is available via the Early Help Access Point for Early Help cases.

Completion of Early Help Assessment undertaken, with family consent.
Where family needs are escalating and there are concerns that needs/risks exceed Early Help level

Child Protection (significant harm) concerns directed in from single telephone line

REFERRAL TEAM ★

★ Threshold Decision made to progress to Assessment. Assessment undertaken (social care)

Case progresses to Social Work support and intervention S17/47

Threshold not met for assessment (social care)

Step Down to Partner Agency with clear plan

Partner agency continue Early Help support as part of Step-Down plan/Referrer advised to initiate EHA

Step Down to Targeted Early Help Service with clear plan

No Further Action/No consent

OFFENDING PREVENTION TEAM ★
 Decision made that preventative work is required in relation to offending, criminality, ASB, NFA, RUI, (includes work with siblings of offenders).
